<u>Evaluation:</u>	MCQs and class assignments. Certificates will be provided to participants after successful completion of the course.
<u>Course fee:</u>	Rs. 50 only.

Programme outcome:

- The students, after completion of the course, are expected to gain substantial awareness of the different avenues leading outwards from the core area of literary studies.
- They are expected to acquire knowledge of different approaches towards using the English language to suit the needs of wide-ranging linguistic structures.
- They will be trained in the techniques and subtleties of channelizing their skills of English composition (learned at the school level) as well as their powers of critical reading and nuanced thinking (learned at the level of higher education) towards upcoming areas of literary studies such as creative media writing, screenplay production or translation.
- Not all students can afford to study just for the pleasures of knowledge. Many have to pass their student lives in painful anxiety of the spectre of unemployment. Traditional curricula of our universities hardly take this into account and career concerns are ignored in classrooms. This course aims to address this serious issue too and expects to equip the students with a commanding view of the sprawling vistas of career options after graduation.

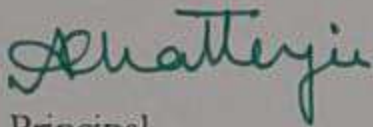

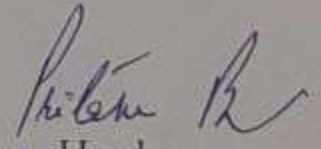


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
