

## Title: Poster Designing Competition

Date: June 14-29, 2021

Mode: Online

Entries: 30

**Objective:** To make the students aware of the evils of gender based discrimination and sexual harassment and involve them in raising further awareness by expressing their thoughts on these issues through the medium of art.

**Context:** Despite the progress that our society has made in achieving equality between the sexes, gender based discriminations still remain a burning issue. In this context, the importance of raising awareness about these issues and involving the young generation in the fight against such social evils cannot be overemphasized.

**Practice:** The Internal Complaints Committee and Gender Sensitization Committee jointly organized a gender sensitization programme through awareness films and poster designing for the students of the college in June 2021. Two short films (available on YouTube)-- one on female foeticide and the other on the various forms of sexual harassment faced by women-- were circulated among the students of the college to spread awareness about these problems. Then those interested were asked to engage with the issues raised by the films and submit their responses in the form of posters. Responses were accepted till 29th June, 2021. The members of ICC selected the winning entries for display on the college website.

**Evidence of success:** Around **thirty posters** were received, all of which were quite well thought-out and beautifully executed. They clearly indicated that the students did not participate for the sake of participation only, but were genuinely involved in the process. Thus the programme was successful in creating awareness even if on a very small scale.

**Problems Encountered:** Since the college was closed because of the pandemic induced lockdown, the organizers could not reach out to a major section of the students and hence the programme could not be carried out on a large scale.

Four states in India have an SRI (Sex ratio at birth) equal to or below 840: Andhra Pradesh and Rajasthan (806), Bihar (807), Uttarakhand (825), and Tamil Nadu (840).
