## **SUBMISSION GUIDELINES**

### **1. Types of Manuscripts Accepted**

Topics with interdisciplinary approaches from the fields of Bengali, English, and Sanskrit Languages and Literature, as well as from various fields of the Humanities and Social Sciences, are welcome.

### **3. Manuscript Submission Process**

#### **3.1 Submission Mode**

Manuscripts must be submitted via email to: [aureole.arts@bgc.ac.in](mailto:aureole.arts@bgc.ac.in)

#### **3.2 Cover Letter Requirements**

Include the manuscript title, article type, originality statement, conflict of interest declaration, author details, and corresponding author information.

### **4. Manuscript Preparation Guidelines**

#### **4.1 Formatting Requirements**

Language: Bengali, English, or Sanskrit. Font: For Times New Roman (For English), Kalpurush (for Bengali), Baraha (for Sanskrit), Font 12, spacing 1.5, justified text, 1-inch margins, page numbering. Use Diacritical Marks for International Sanskrit Translation.

### **5. Manuscript Structure**

#### **5.1 Title Page**

Title, authors, affiliations, ORCID (optional), corresponding author email, acknowledgements.

## **5.2 Abstract & Keywords**

Abstract: 150–250 words, 3–6 keywords.

## **5.3 Main Text**

**Research Articles:** 4000 words

Quotations

Short quotations: within the text, in quotation marks

Long quotations (block quotes): Indented

## **5.4 Citations and References**

AUREOLE requires a single citation style used consistently. All notes/References will appear as END-NOTE. APA 7th edition is recommended.

### **5.4.1 General Principles**

- Match each in-text citation with its reference list entry.
- Use DOIs when available.
- Arrange alphabetically; order chronologically for multiple works by the same author.
- Apply a hanging indent.
- Avoid unreliable web sources.

### **5.4.2 Sample References**

APA Format Example-

#### **Book**

Author's last name, Initial(s). (Year of publication). Title of the book. Publisher.

Example: Amanda, A. (2019). Citing Sources: How to Cite a Book. Academic Press.

#### **Book-Chapter**

Author's last name, Initial(s). (Year of publication). Chapter Title. In Editor(s)' Lastname, Initial as Eds, Title of the Book. (pp.) Publisher.

Example- Barney, B. (2019.) A Chapter in an Edited Collection. In Smith. J, (Ed), A Book of Examples, (pp. 25–35). Academic Press.

#### **Journal-**

Author's last name, Initial(s). (Year of publication). Title of the article. Title of Journal, Volume (Issue), Pages.

Example- Daniels, D. and Williams, B. M. (2014). Journal Article Title. Journal of Academic Research, 32 (15), 232–265.

[ ]/ Website. as applicable)

#### **5.4.3 Additional Recommendations**

Use Mendeley/Zotero/EndNote; verify all citation matches.

### **6. Figures, Tables, and Illustrations**

#### **6.1 Figures**

- Submit figures in **JPEG/PNG/TIFF**, minimum **300 dpi resolution**.
- Each figure must have a **number** and a **caption**, placed below the figure.

#### **6.2 Tables**

- Tables should be numbered sequentially and placed close to the first citation.
- Captions must appear **above** the table.

#### **6.3 Permissions**

If figures/tables are reproduced from copyrighted sources, authors must obtain **written permission**.

### **7. Ethical Responsibilities**

Originality, plagiarism threshold 10–15%, authorship validity, conflict of interest declarations.

### **8. Peer Review Policy**

AUREOLE follows a rigorous single-blind peer-review process.

#### **8.1 Initial Editorial Screening**

Assessment for scope, originality, quality, adherence to guidelines, and plagiarism threshold.

#### **8.2 Single-Blind Review**

- Manuscripts that pass initial screening are sent to two subject experts.
- Reviewer identities remain concealed from the authors during the review process.
- Reviewers evaluate scholarly merit, clarity, methodology, validity of results, grounding in the literature, interpretative strength, and ethical compliance.
- Recommendations guide editorial decisions.
- Names of the reviewers will be mentioned in the published article.

#### **8.3 Possible Editorial Decisions**

- Accept
- Minor Revision

- Major Revision
- Reject

#### **8.4 Revision and Resubmission**

Authors must give detailed, point-by-point responses. Significant revisions might need another review. Multiple revision rounds can occur.

#### **8.5 Typical Timeline**

Screening 1–2 weeks; review 2–4 weeks; revisions 2–4 weeks; final decision and proofs 1–2 weeks.

#### **9. Post-Acceptance Procedures**

Proofs returned within 5–7 days; copyright/licensing requirements.

#### **10. Publication Charges**

Nominal charges will be applied for obtaining printed articles.
