## FILLING IN OF EXAMINATION FORMS UG SEMESTER-VI EXAMINATIONS 2025 (CBCS System)

The undersigned is directed to notify for information of all concerned fees for Semester-VI Examinations of 2025 under CBCS pattern of Examination for the B.A./B.Sc./B.Com. Honours / General/ Major Degree Courses of the University as follows. The fees are to be paid by each candidate at the time of filling in the Examination form at his/her college. Total fees are to be submitted by the candidate through Debit/ Credit Card/ Net Banking, a receipt of which will be retained along with application form finally generated. **The candidates those who had appeared but having backlog in their previous Semesters I to V Examinations, shall be allowed to appear for the forthcoming UG CBCS Semester-VI Examinations 2025. However such candidates must have to pass the other uncleared backlogs / courses within the stipulated time period of Maximum Five (05) years from the year of admission in the 1<sup>st</sup> Semester.**

**“All the students eligible to appear for this Examination are strongly advised to provide their ABC ID while doing Form-Fill in.**

**This only would enable them to access their academic documents from DIGILOCKER site in future.”**

## **Annexure-II**

The amount of Centre fees received by Examination Centres for conducting Practical examinations is to be disbursed by the Centres in the following manner:

- 10% of the total amount received by the Centre towards Overhead expenses
- 40% towards cost of conducting Practical (samples, materials, apparatus etc.)
- 25% towards refreshment of the examiners and other personnel & college staff involved in the Practical.
- 12.5% towards Contingency expenses and
- 12.5% service charges to Non – Teaching staff.
