P.G. ADMISSION (ACADEMIC SESSION 2023-24)

In pursuance of the Notification No. 439-Edn (CS)/10M-95/14 dated 13th July, 2023 of the Department of Higher Education, Government of West Bengal, online application for the admission to 2-year M.A./M.Sc Courses shall be started from 1st September, 2023 and the completion of application in the online portal for the said course will be on 15th September, 2023 (11.59 P.M.)

GUIDELINES AND SEAT ALLOCATION FOR PG ADMISSION IN THE SESSION 2023-24

Admission for M.A./M.Sc in different subjects (Bengali, Botany, Physics and Zoology) will take place through submission of forms on-line to be started on and from 1st of September, 2023 available in the college website. In pursuance of the Notification No. 439 - Edn(CS)/10M-95/14 dated 13th July, 2023 of the Department of Higher Education, Government of West Bengal, the ratio for Home University and other University students shall be 80:20. However, the unfilled Home University Seats, if any, will be filled up by the outside University students and vice versa in PG courses.

Criteria for admission:

- On-line admission process will be done purely on the basis of merit. **Merit Marks will be calculated** from 20% marks at the Secondary level, 20% marks at the Higher Secondary level and 60% marks obtained by a candidate in the Honours Subject.

- Candidates applying for Post-Graduation in Zoology must have Chemistry as one of the General Elective subjects in undergraduate level.
- Candidates applying for Post-Graduation in Botany may have Chemistry, Zoology, Microbiology, Biochemistry, Physiology, Molecular Biology, Biotechnology as one of the General Elective subjects in undergraduate level.
- Preference will be given to the marks of the most relevant General Elective subject in case of candidates scoring equal Merit Marks in the Honours.
- Admission criteria for **Bengali (PG)**, candidates securing better marks in Bengali at Higher Secondary level will be given first preference and second preference will be given to the candidates with better marks in the subject at secondary examination level if other marks are equal.
- Admission criteria for **Physics (PG)**, candidates securing better marks in Mathematics (General Elective) at B.Sc. level will be given preference if other marks are equal.
- Admission criteria for **Zoology (PG)**, candidates securing better marks in Chemistry General Elective at B.Sc. level will be given preference if other marks remain equal.
- Candidates applying for PG in Botany must have Chemistry as one of the subjects in Higher Secondary (HS) level. Candidates securing better marks in Chemistry at HS level will be given preference, if other marks remain equal.

Reservation of seats is as per Govt. Rules.

- Admission for the ensuing session 2023-24 will be made online (stand-alone-mode and details of which is as follows :
 - 1) Prospective students would not be called for counseling or verification of documents during the process of admission. No physical presence is required at the colleges.
 - 2) Eligible applicants will be informed directly by the college authority through email or message.
 - 3) Payment of fees is to be done only through e-payment mode.
 - 4) Bank will receive admission fees on the basis of corrected merit list.

There is no online prospectus fee for the admission in the PG Programmes.


- Verification of necessary documents would be done physically when the students report for the classes in due course. Admission will be cancelled if the documents are found not in conformity with the declaration in the forms submitted online.
- Photo copies of SC/ST certificate to be submitted at the time of admission from competent authorities.

- Photo copies of OBC-A/OBC-B/EWS certificate to be submitted at the time of admission from competent authorities.
- Candidates passed during the year 2023 are eligible to apply for post-graduation. **In case of the 2022 passed candidates a deduction of 2% will be considered from the Merit Marks** obtained in the corresponding Honours subjects.
- Verification of necessary documents would be done when the students report for the classes in due course. Admission will be cancelled if the documents are found not in conformity with the declaration in the forms submitted online.

Candidates need to bring the following items for verification

1. Money receipt of the online payment (generated through admission portal)
 2. Duly signed and filled up admission form
 3. Two copies of passport-size self photographs
 4. Photocopies of the requisite documents clipped with the form, original copies of all the testimonials at the time of commencement of classes.
 5. Admission fee receipt of requisite amount (generated during online admission of the selected candidates).
