- The members will reconvene for the judgement tentatively on 30th June 2021 at 8 pm.
- It was also resolved that the ICC will collaborate with the English Department which approached the Committee to conduct an online gender sensitization programme for the students of the department. The programme will be conducted by Debapratim Chakraborty on either 28th or 29th June according to the convenience of the speaker and the department.
