MINUTES

IQAC Meeting of Barasat Government College held on 28 April, 2023

- The meeting began with Dr. Madhusudan Ghosh expressing his concern about the deterioration in the quality of
 performance of students in the recently held University examinations. He stressed on the necessity of the
 preparation of a properly documented policy for addressing this problem. Slow learners need to be identified and
 given special attention, he stated.
 - Dr. Prabir Bhattacharya, Teachers' Council Secretary, enquired about the current situation of remedial classes in the college. The modalities of remedial classes were discussed in detail. Different methods such as tutorial classes, one-to-one teaching, teaching by students themselves etc. were discussed.
- Dr. Abhijit De harped on the relevance of PTMs in urging students to be regular in classes. The Principal instructed all
 departments to prepare a list of their slow learners / weak students and devote some extra classes to their
 improvement. He also suggested that student defaulters may be made to attend online remedial classes. Teachers
 from outside the college may also be invited to deliver lectures / talks for them.
- Dr. Madhusudan Ghosh next deliberated on the importance of Question Banks for CBCS based courses and requested all departments to submit question papers (real and sample) to IQAC. It was decided that for Internal examinations only model questions will be submitted. They will be substantial in number and should cover the entire syllabus.
- The Principal suggested that classes during first 15 days of the summer vacation are to be held according to the routine that is in effect now.
- It was decided that all departments will hold PTMs for at least Semesters 2 and 4 within the month of May. The last PTMs were held in January.
- Dr. Dola Chattopadhyay mentioned the importance and efficacy of forming separate Whatsapp groups with parents / guardians of each batch.
- The Principal asked all teachers to prepare 2 audio-visual or pdf lectures for the Swayam portal.
- Dr. Madhusudan Ghosh reminded all departments that all supporting documents relating to old AQARs should be submitted as soon as possible.
- Next, the notification for the foundation of **Science Club** was read out by Dr. Madhusudan Ghosh. The objective of this Science Club will be as follows:

"To create a common platform for exchange of scientific knowledge, innovative thinking and promotion of scientific temperament among all science students."
