- 3. It was suggested by Prof Samrajnee Dutta that the future meetings with External Members to be held in Online Mode to ensure their presence.
- 4. Principal Samar Chattopadhyaysuggested the names of the Deputy Secretary and former student of BGC Prof Rajat Bandopadhyay from Calcutta University, and Chairman of Barasat Municipalityas External Members.
- 5. IQAC Committee Composition to be uploaded on the College website on urgent basis.
- 6. Details of actions taken on FuturePlans as per AQAR Report 2020-2021to be filled-in in Part A of AQAR Report 2021-22, along with Future Plans for current session.
- 7. Sets of persons to be engaged in collecting data (from the various committees of the college) as per given format [Excel Sheets] for the different criterions in Part B of AQAR Report 2021-22.
- 8. Status of College Affiliation- to be enlisted as PG College.
- 9. Prof Dola Chattopadhyay to help Prof SG regarding preparation of Crit. 3 data, alongside updating Crit. 5 data.
- 10. Prof Indranath Bhattacharyya proposed (i) adopting *Statistics* as a GE subject (with permission from the University)in AQAR Report 2020-21; (ii) Tracking Students' Progression in detail by maintaining the Whatsapp groups after completion of graduation, especially for General candidates of Morning Session; proposal accepted by Principal, Prof Abhijit Dey and Prof Dola Chattopadhyay.
