Introduction:

In order to promote activities on Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) the National Intellectual Property Awareness Mission (NIPAM) was framed up by the Office of the Controller General of Patents Design & Trademarks (CGPDTM, Mumbai) under the Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT) Ministry of Commerce and Industry, Government of India on 8th December 2021. The prime ambitious objective of this National level Mission (Pan-India) has been to provide awareness on IPR to 1 million students. The main aim is to inculcate the spirit of creativity and innovation to students of higher education, ignite and inspire the students of College/Universities to innovate and protect their creations. The main emphasis of the Ministry of the Government of India is an effort to initiate the importance of the role of a strong IPR ecosystem in the advancement of a country and realise that IPR is an important tool for the IP holder to become a “job giver rather than job seeker”. Further, the Joint Secretary, DPIIT and CGPDTM motivated the officers of CGPDTM to spread awareness on IP so that a more conducive environment of innovation and creativity is established in the country.
