As a government college it has achieved a very pertinent position in the academic atmosphere of the district as well as the State as a whole. Our college offers different courses like B.A., B.sc Hons, General and Postgraduation courses for several subjects. It runs **Thirteen** UG departments and **four** PG departments namely Bengali, Zoology, Physics and Botany. Presently nearly **3000** students are studying here. The College has a strong and active Internal Quality Assurance Cell since **2010.** No doubt Feedback Analysis is an essential element of the learning process of today. IQAC designs and collects feedback from its stakeholders to monitor and evaluate the quality of performance on teaching learning experiences, evaluation process, curriculum development, available infrastructure, safety - security and overall atmosphere of the college. Four different types of feedbacks have been collected from stake holders students, teachers, guardians, and from alumni.

Feedbacks have been collected through a structured and rating based google feedback form. Collected feedbacks have been analyzed and a comprehensive report has been prepared accordingly.

#### Objective of the Our Feedback Analysis:

- a) The most important objective of our "Feedback Analysis" is to improve the teaching learning atmosphere of the college.
- b) Moreover, we want to get an idea about actual progress of the academic and allied system of the college.
- c) To find out the inadequacies of the available infrastructures.
- d) To identify the lag areas regarding the overall performance of different activities of the college and to search the scope for betterment.
- e) Also to detect the various strengths of the institution as a whole.
- f) After proper analysis to rectify all the shortcomings, get reflected in the feedbacks, as far as possible
- g) To strengthen the positive aspects of the institution, to push the institution to a new height in the future.

### Methodology

We have collected altogether following five various types of feedbacks from the stake holders.


- a) Students feedback on college infrastructure
- b) Feedback from existing teachers of the college.
- c) Feedback from Guardians regarding different aspects of the college.
- d) Feedback from Alumni.
- e) Students feedback regarding teaching, learning and evaluation

All feedbacks have been collected through a structured and mostly rating based google form. First four forms have been designed, collected and analyzed by the IQAC of the college. On the other hand Students feedback regarding teaching learning and evaluation process has been designed and collected jointly by the respective departments and IQAC. But analyzed and preserved by the department itself.

## STUDENT FEEDBACK ON COLLEGE INFRASTRUCTURE

#### STUDENT PARTICIPATION

A 15-point questionnaire comprising of several questions regarding available infrastructure of the college has been used here. We have in total 1266 student respondents among which 58.1 % are from UG honors course, 35.9 % from UG general course and 6 % PG students. Semester wise distribution of these 1266 students is given below. We have highest respondents from UG semester II students almost 41.9%. UG Sem IV has also a subsistent share of almost 34.9 %.




#### LIBRARY FACILITY

A well-equipped, arranged ,spacious Library has an immense contribution for creating an enriched teaching learning ambiance. In our questionnaire there are several questions regarding different library facilities like availability of books, reading room, internet facility, cooperation from library staff etc. The result showed that most of the students expressed their satisfaction over different library facilities. 61.1 % of the student respondents remained satisfied regarding availability of books, over 60.9% remained satisfied regarding reading room facility over 67.1 % students agreed about the cooperation of library staff. Almost 61 % expressed their satisfaction over availability of internet facility in the library. KOHA has been updated to an advanced version from this academic year. INFLIBNET sources has been extensively used by faculties and students in this academic year.


### RESPONSES REGARDING LIBRARY FACILITIES

3. Whether books are available in the central library 1,266 responses




4. Whether library staff are helpful


5. Whether Reading Room facilities are satisfactory


6. Whether internet facility is available in the library and college premises


#### SAFETY SECURITY AND CLEANLINESS OF THE CAMPUS

Safety security and cleanliness within the campus is a must for any college. In this respect college remained always very much aware. So We have incorporated several questions regarding safety security within the college premises. Students are highly, 79.6 %, agreed that college premises are secure and safe for them. Almost 80.1% students said that college have enough sources of safe drinking water. Regarding the availability of clean toilet we have received rather dissatisfied result, about 24.4 % said that there is not adequate number of clean toilets for both boys and girls within the college campus.




#### OTHER INFRASTRUCTURAL FACILITIES

In order to maintain a smooth and sound academic atmosphere required infrastructural facilities include uninterrupted power backup system, facility for games and sports, availability of cheap store and photocopy centre etc. Most of the students expressed their satisfaction in these regards 64.3 % are highly satisfied for power backup system, 66.2 % for opportunity of games and sports but for availability of cheap store and photocopy center we received rather dissatisfied responses,14.7 % respondents are still dissatisfied.



#### FREE AND FAIR ATMOSPHERE


Free and fair atmosphere is a basic need for creating a perfect academic ambience. There should some special arrangements to support physically challenged students. Over 67% students remained satisfied regarding their opportunity and freedom to raise their own voice about several activities within the college. More than 73.1% respondents agreed that college has provided a transparent and quality academic atmosphere for pursuit of their studies. Over 76.8% students stated that college authority is enough supportive towards the students with physical disability.


### TEACHERS FEEDBACK ON COLLEGE PREMISES AND FACILITIES

IQAC have collected feedback from teachers also. For this purpose a 16 point google questionnaire has been used. Barasat Government College have all together 13 undergraduate departments and 4 post graduate departments. Department wise, designation wise and course wise distribution of respondent teachers is given below.




#### REGARDING COURSE CONTENT

Teachers are directly involved and always deal with the course content. So in our questionnaire several questions have been included regarding the efficacy of the course contents to the teachers. From the teachers of the college mixed responses have been received. Regarding the suitability of the course almost 72% of the respondents have expressed satisfaction. In the same way over 70% have agreed that the course properly fulfils the need of the students whether other 30% have negative or moderate view in this regard. About the aim and objectives of the syllabus o ver75% have chosen higher and highest ranks but the remaining 25 % gave only medium or poor ranking. Regarding the academic flexibility over 68 % of the respondent remained satisfied.




**STUDY MATERIALS:** Study material is an integral part of the course content. There should be arrangement for sufficient and relevant study material for the students. Over 85% of the responded have opined that course content has been sufficiently followed by appropriate reference materials. Almost 75% respondent teachers expressed that sufficient number of books are available in the library. 61.2% respondents agreed that course content have sufficient optional papers. Over 83% respondents said that reference materials are relevant, up to date and appropriate for the concerned courses. Uploading of study materials to college website is a continuous process in our college.




#### COLLEGE INFRASTRUCTURE AND ACADEMIC ATMOSPHERE

70.2 % teacher respondents remained satisfied regarding number and condition of teachers room, class rooms, reading rooms, laboratory, rest rooms and toilet in the college, 91 % respondent agreed that internal tests are being conducted in time and properly cover all units of the syllabus. Over 77.6% of the respondent teachers have assured that there is freedom to adopt new innovative techniques for teaching in the college. 80.6 % teachers have stated that the environment in the respective departments is conductive for teaching and for research work.




### 11. Freedom to adopt new innovation/techniques of teaching.





# 12. The environment in the department/College is conducive to teaching and research. 67 responses




#### PROFESSIONAL TRANSPARENCY


Professional transparency is utmost needed so that a teacher can freely participate in teaching learning process. According to the views of 88 % of the respondent teachers college authorities are approachable and helpful. Over 85 % teachers responded that there is appropriate mechanism for feedback, review and performance enhancement for the teaching staffs. Near about 75 % teachers said that there is good recognition about the individual works. Over 83% teachers remained agreed that professional development process are non-discriminatory and fair.








#### 15. Recognition of the individual work is given.



## 16. Provisions for professional development are non-discriminatory and fair. 67 responses





### FEEDBACK FROM PARENTS

Our third stakeholders are parents of the students. College always maintained a direct coordination with the parents in order to make them aware about their ward's progress. Each and every department organize parents- teachers meeting at every semester. In addition to that to get their opinion regarding different aspects of teaching learning procedure feedbacks have been collected via google form. This year a large number of parents participated in this survey. We have got 1274 responses. We set a 9 points questionnaire for parents' feedback. Over 92 % of the respondents are from parents of undergraduate students.

85.2% of respondent parents remained highly satisfied regarding the safety of their wards within the college campus. More than 91% respondent are more or less satisfied about library, laboratory and internet facility available in the college. In 96.8% cases parents reported that college took enough financial care for fulfilling the needs of poor but meritorious students. 97% of them responded that academic and co curricular activities so far undertaken by the college during the year remained satisfactory. 95.9% of parents said that sufficient level of academic guidance and counselling have been provided by the college to their wards. more than 94% of parents are informed regarding progress of their wards through parents – teacher forum. more than 96% parents responded that teachers remained approachable in cases they have any query regarding their wards.


#### DISTRIBUTION OF RESPONDENTS AMONG COURSES


3. Whether the college premises are secure in your opinion?




6. Whether you are satisfied with facilities like Library, Laboratory, Internet access, Cheap store etc that are offered to your ward?


7. Whether the college takes effort in addressing financial needs of poor but meritorious students? 1,274 responses


4. Whether you are satisfied with the academic and co-curricular activities under taken at the college?


5. Whether sufficient level of academic guidance and counselling is provided by the college to your ward?


8. Whether the College informs you about the academic progress of your ward through parent-teacher forum?






### FEEDBACK FROM ALUMNI

Alumni of the college have always taken an important role for the improvement of every College. They are most loyal supporter and best ambassador of a college. Very often Alumni are a regular source of valuable fund which can be used for different development project of the college. Our college has a vast and extended alumni network. Each department maintain a regular and positive relation with their alumni. Suggestions from alumni plays a valuable role for the betterment of the college and specially to guide career courses of the current students. We have collected feedback from alumni using a 9 point google questionnaire. But it is little bit different from other three forms. At the very beginning of our survey, we took responses from our alumni for 19 parameters such as---Admission procedure, faculty, library, laboratory & equipment, classroom, internet facility, canteen, sport& cultural facility etc... We may point out some of the outstanding findings in this regard....Nearly 60 % agreed that faculty is excellent.

A large section of the alumni (almost 50) has viewed that academic atmosphere, provision of clean drinkingwater and overall security in the college premises are excellent. For those categories where the responses are not so satisfactory the college will take adequate steps in near future.







#### **SOME OTHER FINDINGS**

It is an achievement for a college that over 96.1 % alumni feel proud to be an alumnus/alumna of our college. Not only that 88.3 % of them are eager to donate fund. Among the respondents 60.2% are in favor of increasing the involvement of alumni in the development of college. We have set several questions regarding syllabus, curriculum, cocurricular activity, teaching learning process and overall atmosphere of the college in the alumni feedback form. Among them 32 % of respondents have attended Alumni meetings. In the question of the need to improve teaching learning process of the college 50.5 % remained agree. 58.3 % of the respondents feel no need to change the syllabi or curriculum.


The last question in the 9-point feedback form was regarding the need of any change in the general environment of the department and the college as a whole and attitude of the people. Here 34 % remain neutral and 6.7 % stayed completely disagree. Where 49.6 % feel the need of changing the atmosphere. This way we have tried to cover a vast area from where we can collect the views of our alumni. We hope these extensive views from our alumni surely help in designing future development plan for the college.




## 4. Have you participated in any Alumni meet as of now? 103 responses



## 5. Is there a need to improve the teaching and learning process? $^{103}$ responses




## 6. Is there a need for any change in curriculum and syllabi? $^{103}$ responses

#### **OBSERVATIONS**

- 1. We have got less than 50% responses from all categories. 1266 students responded out of 2916 students regarding college infrastructure. It means that we cannot reach most of the students properly to get their responses. Parents and Alumni feedback expresses the same status.
- 2. Clean toilet facilities for both male and female students should be increased, Only 43.9% of student respondents remained completely satisfied regarding the provision of clean toilets.
- 3. There is a need to increase the availability of services of photocopy centres and cheap stores within the college campus. Regarding this facility 14.7% of respondents expressed their dissatisfaction.
- 4. Availability of books in the Central library, internet facility and reading room facility should be enhanced, almost 40% of respondents are moderately or not satisfied in this regard.
- 5. According to teachers' view it will be better to improve the suitability of the syllabus, applicability of the course content and academic flexibility of the curriculum.
- 6. College infrastructure such as teachers' room classrooms, reading rooms, laboratory restrooms and toilets should be improved both in number and quality.
- 7. Alumni involvement is very much poor only 32% attended the meetings.
- 8. For the 19 parameters regarding the overall atmosphere of the college such as Faculty standard, Availability of drinking water, Academic atmosphere, overall security in the college, Training placement, sports & cultural facilities, seminars & workshops etc where a rating-based response has been set up, we got very average feedback from the alumni group.
- 9. According to a section of alumni respondents it is required to improve the general environment of the department /college and the attitude of the people.
