What is most determining in the entire process is the organic link with a particular reality that always leaves an imprint in the construction of ideas. European nationalist ideas which influenced the Indian nationalists did have limitations in the particular socio-economic context of Africa and Asia due to their alien origin. Thus the European nationalist trail is indigenised substantially by inventing indigenous equivalents and investing these with additional meanings and nuances.
- **PSO7:** The two basic forces or elements of nationalism and democratisation are imparted in the courses esp. Constitutional and comparative political processes. These enable and will be of great assistance for the students who will pursue higher studies in different fields. These will help them in choosing their future professions. So, this course definitely helps as a career builder for the student community.
