Brief Report:

On May 24, 2023, a seminar titled “Geo-Archaeology & Its Relevance: A Case Study of Chandraketugarh & Debalgarh” was held, with Mr. Rahul Chakraborty, Director of the Integrated Institute for Advanced Research and Information, as the keynote speaker. Organized by the IQAC, P.G. Department of Botany, and the Department of Geography, the event attracted 52 participants. Mr. Chakraborty introduced geo-archaeology as an interdisciplinary field combining geological and archaeological methods to explore ancient human-environment interactions. The seminar focused on two sites: Chandraketugarh, an ancient port city that thrived from the 3rd century BCE to the 6th century CE, and Debalgarh, a lesser-known urban center. Through geo-archaeological techniques such as sediment analysis and remote sensing, Mr. Chakraborty explained how environmental changes, like river course shifts and floods, influenced these ancient settlements. The Ganges River played a crucial role in the prosperity and eventual decline of Chandraketugarh. Mr. Chakraborty emphasized the significance of geo-archaeology in understanding how ancient societies adapted to environmental challenges, offering valuable insights for modern climate resilience. The seminar concluded with discussions on the importance of preserving archaeological sites and leveraging modern technology to uncover the environmental history of these regions.
