**Date of Programme:** 08.03.2022

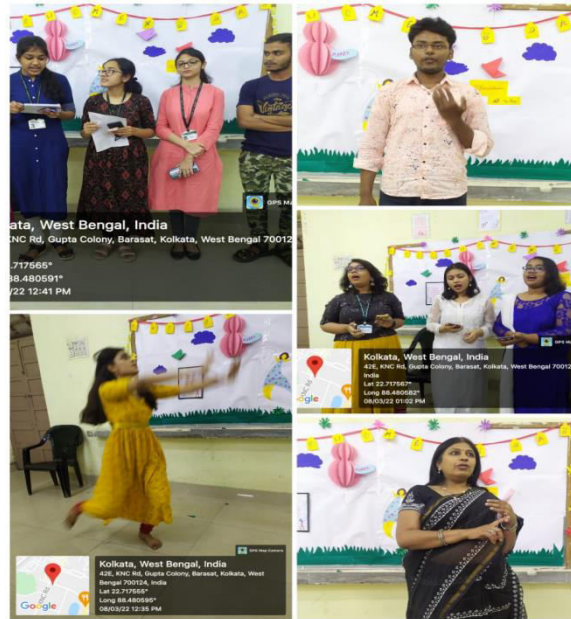
