

Special Lecture on History of Early Islam (in relation to Intizar Hussain's Basti)






Introduction: This special talk on the history of Early Islam was conceived as a supplement to the students' reading of the novel *Basti* which is a part of the Partition Literature paper. Since the novel makes frequent references to various Islamic historical events particularly the Karbala as well as Islamic myths and legends, it was necessary to provide the students with a clear background of Islamic history.

Brief Report: The speaker lucidly charted the history of Islam from its inception to the fateful battle of Karbala and the schism it brought about. He also discussed the major legends surrounding the life of Prophet Muhammad as well as the basic tenets of the Islamic faith while outlining the differences between Shia and Sunni denominations. The lecture was student friendly and extremely informative and would enhance their understanding of the Islamic references in their prescribed text.
