# PROGRAMME OUTCOME - 2022-2023 DEPARTMENT OF GEOGRAPHY

## 1. Title of the Programme: Add On Course on Advance Field Survey Techniques Date of Programme: 11-14 March 2023

An Add On Course was conducted by the Department of Geography from 11<sup>th</sup> to 14<sup>th</sup> March 2023, spanning from 11:30 AM to 4:00 PM. 51 students participated in this programme. The external resource person Dr. Aznarul Islam, Assistant Professor in Geography, Aliah University and internal resource persons covered comprehensive surveying techniques, incorporating Theodolite, Dumpy Level, and Advanced GNSS methodologies. Participants gained practical insights, enhancing their skill in field survey practices.



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# 2. Title of the Programme: Add On Course on Applied Field Research Methods Date of Programme: 15-16 March 2023

The Department of Geography, organised another Add on Course on Applied Field Research Methods, held on 15<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup> March 2023 from 11:30 AM to 4:00 PM. 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## 9. Title of the Programme: Academic Visit to Range Office of the WBFD Date of Programme: 23 June 2023


