Nature and Duration: This value-added course is a certificate programme. Total Contact Hours will be 36.

Application: The course can be attended by applying offline and reporting to the Head, Department of Chemistry, Barasat Govt. College within scheduled time frame.

Target Participants: Students of this college belonging to various Honours and General Programme.

Mode of teaching: Entire process of teaching, learning, and evaluation for the programme will be conducted on Sundays and Holidays starting from 18.10.2019 to 25.10.2019.

Faculty: The programme modules will be taught by experienced faculty members (teachers) of this college.

Intake Capacity: Maximum intake capacity is 350 with a minimum cut-off number of 50 candidates.

Programme Structure:

- Module I: Skill Development in languages, mathematics, general knowledge and science.
- Module II: Quantitative Aptitude and Data Interpretation
- Module III Computer Application and its Modalities

Mode of Evaluation: The evaluation process will be carried out throughout the programme duration by a combination of the following methods.

- Performance throughout the course (40% weightage).
- Attendance (20% weightage).
- Objective assessment (40% weightage).

Evaluation of the performance of the student based on a total of 100 % will be rated as shown in the following table.
