





Faculties from the University of Denver, Roche Pharma Solution, Switzerland, King Fahad University of Petroleum and Minerals, Saudi Arabia, Birla Institute of Engineering and Technology, Goa, University of Madras, Chennai, HRDC-University of Calcutta, Diamond Harbour Women's University etc. were delighted to share their expertise and experience with the students. A total of 432 candidates applied for this certificate course. Out of them 77 candidates have participated in this event. Based on the attendance, continuous performance, project work, and end evaluation 36 successful participants were awarded the certificate.
