An Outreach programme entitled "Conserve Today, Sustain Tomorrow" was organized on 14th May, 2025 by Environment Protection and Nature Cell, Barasat Government College, and the team visited Kishalaya Home, Barasat to raise awareness about the environment and sustainable development among the children. Four faculties and nine students visited the home. The inaugural speech was delivered by Jt. Convener, Dr. Jayati Ghosh, Associate professor of Zoology. Dr. Dhananjay Roy, Associate Professor of Physics presented a lecture entitled "Aware and reduction of Pollution for a healthy sustainable environment". Dr. Angana Chatterjee, Associate Professor of Philosophy also accompanied the team. The students from both UG and PG Department of Botany and Zoology discussed the various topics on the environment as follows:

1. Plastic pollution: Debarjun Pal and Somik Sarkar, UG Semester VI, Botany.
2. Water Conservation: Koyel Ghosh and Saheli Parvin, UG Semester I, Zoology.
3. Climate Change: Zishan Islam, UG Semester IV, Zoology.
4. Biodiversity Conservation: Ayan Biswas and Sangbartta Ghosh, PG Semester II, Botany.
5. Green energy: Surajuddin, UG Semester IV, Zoology.
6. Sustainable living: Subhapiya Naskar, PG Semester IV, Botany.
7. Somik Sarkar and Subhapiya Naskar of the Botany department also presented posters.

The students from the home attentively listened and interacted during the presentation and discussion. A quiz competition was held among the students on the relevant topics, in which 15 awards were given to the students. The total number of students and staff members that participated in the program was 25. Sri Tanmay Biswas, Superintendent of the home was present during the presentation by students and quiz competition. He expressed importance and significance of holding such a programme for the home children and appreciated this outreach effort on behalf of Barasat Government College. A vote of thanks was delivered by Jt. Convener Dr. Rituparna Kundu Chaudhuri, Assistant Professor in Botany.

The programme outcome includes spreading awareness among the children regarding various environmental issues such as air, water, plastic pollution and conservation of natural resources. Through these interactive discussions they were made aware about green or alternative energy and how sustainable practices can be implied in our daily lives to ensure limited utilization as well as conservation of environmental resources that would aid in holistic sustainable development. This capacity building programme also helped in enhancing students' skill and expertise in the field as they presented and discussed the related topics. The quiz programme instilled enthusiasm and inquisitiveness within the young minds. The whole programme would help to accumulate knowledge and develop environmental consciousness amongst the participants.


We believe that this program will benefit the students of Kishalaya Home and contribute to creating a more environmentally conscious community.

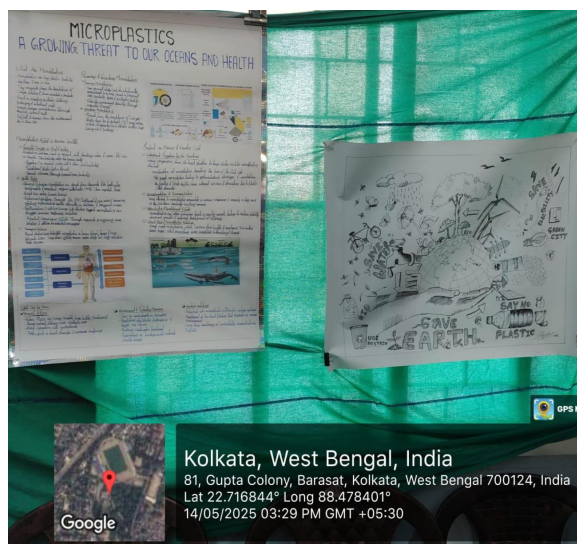
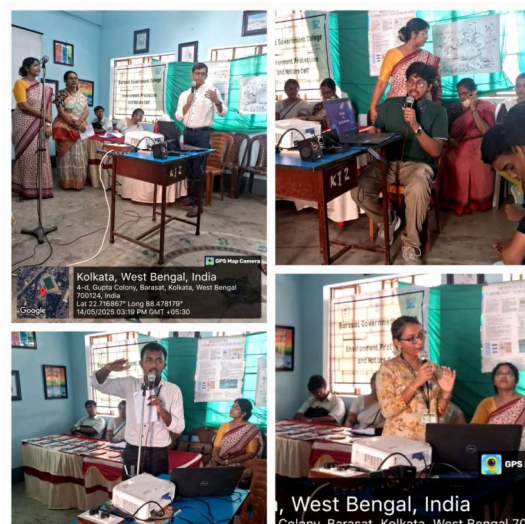
