A Special lecture on **Media Ethics** has been organized by Department of Philosophy in collaboration with IQAC, Barasat Government College on 24.09.2019 in Seminar Hall, Annex Building. Sri Sukalpo Chatterjee, a media personality was the invited speaker.

Sri Chatterjee spoke about the Concept of Media Ethics and its significance in modern day. Media Ethics, deals with specific ethical principles and standards of media which includes social media, internet, film, theatre, arts etc. The speaker spoke regarding the ethical questions about how media should use texts and pictures provided by the citizen. Mr. Chatterjee spoke about the role and functions of media in society. Media, through proper and accurate presentation of any incident, can solve several problems of the society. But on the contrary, misrepresentations and inaccurate reporting of any incident can create new problems of the society. There is an in dispensable relation between media and democracy which should be realised and property maintained.

Taking this webinar to a national audience has been possible for ICPR. Nearly 700 hundred participants from all over India joined the webinar. This webinar was very much relevant to this crisis period. It helped the students as well as all the faculty members to cope with the grave situation. Eminent psychologist and Professor of Psychology Dr. Nilanjana Sanyal and Dr. Saoni Mitra, psychotherapist and professor of psychology had highlighted aspects of mental well-being by their lectures. Dr. Sampananda Mishra enriched us with some insights from yoga for managing life in crisis. Dr. Sushim Dubey also upheld Indian philosophical tradition.
