
# NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME (NSS) BARASAT GOVERNMENT COLLEGE UNIT SESSION – July 2021- June 2022

2 volunteers were participated in said programme.



57 volunteers were participated in said programme.



32 NSS volunteers were present there.











66 volunteers were participated in said programme.





### Day 1: 02.06.2022

In the first half of the Special Camp, the NSS volunteers learned Kanthastitch and Tie and Dye under the programme 'Artist in Me'. These skills can be applied productively on different fabrics. This programme contributes to self-employment of the students in future. Smt. Shilpi Kundu, Fevicryl Certified Specialist and Smt. Joyita Mondal, Fevicryl Certified Expert acted as Resource Persons in the programme.

In the second half of the Camp, Dr. Mihir Halder, Assistant Professor of Botany, Barasat Government College acted as a Resource Person in the awareness programme on 'Conservation of Biodiversity'. The students were made aware of sustainable development for the protection of ecosystem and proper utilization of natural resources for preservation of nature.

Day 2: 03.06.2022
