34 volunteers have participated in this programme.










Date - 01.09.2023

3 Volunteers of the NSS Unit, Barasat Government College are watching the live telecast of 'Meri Maati Mera Desh' programme on 31.10.2023.









Date - 26.11.2023

The program ended with Vote of thanks and NSS clap. 65 NSS Volunteers, Programme Officer and 4 teachers were present in this programme.














Date - 27.03.2024
