M.A. in Bengali	Candidates must have Bengali in undergraduate level.	Candidates securing better marks in Bengali at Higher Secondary level will be given first preference and second preference will be given to the candidates with better marks in the subject at secondary examination level if Merit Score is equal.
M.Sc. in Botany	Candidates must have Chemistry, and Zoology, Microbiology, Molecular Biology, as one of the General Elective subjects in undergraduate level.	Candidates securing better marks in Chemistry at Higher Secondary level will be given preference, if Merit Score remain equal.
M.Sc. in Zoology	Candidates must have Chemistry as one of the General Elective subjects in undergraduate level.	Candidates securing better marks in Chemistry General Elective at B.Sc. level will be given preference if Merit Score remain equal.
M.Sc. in Physics	Candidates must have Mathematics as one of the General Elective subjects in undergraduate level.	Candidates securing better marks in Mathematics (General Elective) at B.Sc. level will be given preference if Merit Score is equal.
