E-certificates were distributed to all successful participants and special rank certificates were provided to the top three rank holders.







Short report on the "Program Outcome" Surviving in a Covid World: Major Issues of India, Organized by Barasat Government College on 3 September 2020

COVID-19 has turned the world upside down. Everything has been impacted. How we live and interact with each other, how we work and communicate, how we move around and travel. Every aspect of our lives has been affected or altered. Although the world was in lockdown, governments, epidemiologists, school principals, entrepreneurs and families around the world are already planning the next steps: how to safely reopen schools and businesses, how to commute and travel without transmitting or contracting infection, how to support those most affected by the crisis – the millions who have lost their livelihoods or their loved ones, how to ensure the already serious inequalities don't deteriorate further.

In this context our institution organized a webinar which was very much related to research methodologies based on recent researches and statistics of Covid 19 entitled "Surviving in a Covid World: Major Issues of India", Organized by Barasat Government College.

Prof. Dr. Pranab Kumar Bhattacharya, Professor & HoD, Dept. of Pathology, Calcutta School of Topical Medicine, Fellow of Royal Society of Topical Medicine & Hygiene (UK), Recipient of Life Time Achievement Award 2019. His topic was **Eitopathogenesis Pathology**, **Clinical Features of Covid19**.

Total participant was 283.

Real-time training during global emergencies is critical for effective preparedness and response. The COVID-19 channel provides learning resources for health professionals, decision-makers and the public for the outbreak of coronavirus disease (COVID-19). As the outbreak continues to evolve, new resources will be added and existing courses will be updated to best reflect the changing context. The report also provided a glimpse into the challenges facing national statistical offices at the moment. At a time when statistics are most needed, many statistical systems are struggling to compile basic statistics, highlighting once again the need to invest in data and statistics, and the importance of having modern national statistical systems and data infrastructure.

Although a wide range of topics are covered in this report, a consistency of message is clear – this is an unprecedented crisis, and no aspect of our lives is immune.

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Programme Outcome : Department of Philosophy, 2020-21

Invited talks, sem/web-inars, peer-meets are the regular academic events of this department. Interactive sessions on different topics by eminent scholars to enrich the students as well as the faculty members and provide them with a better academic exposure is always being one of the strength points of this department. This year is not an exception. Despite pandemic odds, we have arranged several on-line lecture-series to ensure not only the academic aspects of our students, but also their physical and mental balance during that crucial time of our students and also of all the members of our institution. We are privileged and honoured that some of the eminent scholars across the nation had cooperated with us and we are sincerely thankful to Indian Council of Philosophical Research (ICPR) for their financial support. Here is a short report of these academic events and their outcomes with relevant documentation.

1. Online Peer-Lecture, July-August, 2020

Conceptually speaking, Peer-lectures are curriculum based academic activity where, students get benefited by invited peers. This year we are privileged to have with us two eminent professors, Dr. Ratna Dutta Sharma, Formerly Professor, Department of Philosophy, Jadavpur University and Dr. Proyash Sarkar, Professor, Jadavpur University. Dr. Ratna Dutta Sharma delivered lectures on 'Different schools of Indian Philosophy and their Interdependence'. Her thought-provoking lectures enlightened us immensely. Dr. Proyash Sarkar, Professor, had delivered series of lectures on different aspects of Locke's philosophy which help our students to comprehend there with philosophical problems. Approximately, 200 students participated and benefited by this curriculum-based peer-meet lecture. All the recordings of the programme in soft version are restored in the department. 2. International Yoga Day, 31st July, 2020

To commemorate International Yoga Day, Indian Council of Philosophical Research had sanctioned a grant for webinar to our department. The department in

collaboration with Psychological counselling cell and IQAC of the college with the financial assistance of Indian Council of Philosophical Research organized an oneday National webinar on '*Psycho-Spiritual Symbiosis : A Wellbeing Tool for The New Normal*' on 31st July, 2020.Taking this webinar to a national audience has been possible for ICPR. Eminent psychologist and Professor of Psychology Dr. Nilanjana Sanyal and Dr. Saoni Mitra, psychotherapist and professor of psychology had highlighted aspects of mental well-being by their lectures. Dr. Sampananda Mishra enriched us with some insights from yoga for managing life in crisis . Dr. Sushim Dubey also upheld Indian philosophical tradition. 




