

## Report on Gender Sensitisation Programme:

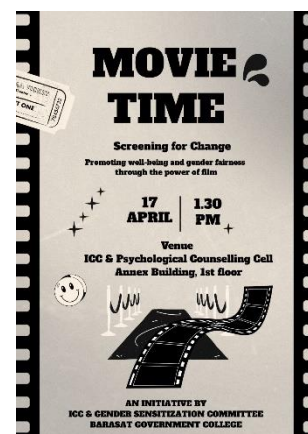
### "Screening for Change"

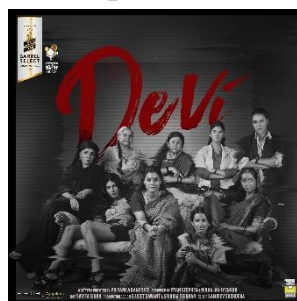
