

## **Gender sensitization workshop organized by the Departments of Mathematics and Economics in collaboration with ICC**

**Date:** 16 August, 2024

**Number of participants:** 37 participants from Mathematics, Economics and Science General Students.

**Objective:** To foster awareness about gender equality and promote respect for all genders in personal and professional environments.

**Brief Report:** The workshop began with an introduction to gender-related concepts, such as gender roles, stereotypes, and the distinction between sex and gender. The facilitator emphasized the importance of recognizing unconscious biases and their impact on society. Through interactive discussions, Film show **JUICE**, case studies, participants explored various scenarios illustrating the challenges faced by individuals due to gender-based discrimination.

The short film **Juice**, directed by Neeraj Ghaywan, is a compelling narrative that subtly addresses the issues of gender roles, inequality, and patriarchy within Indian households.

Overall, students enjoyed **Juice** not just as a short film but as a conversation starter that challenges their perspectives and encourages them to reflect on and advocate for gender equality in their own communities.

Key topics covered included:

**Gender Equality:** Understanding the need for equal opportunities and rights regardless of gender.

**Workplace Harassment:** Recognizing and preventing inappropriate behavior and fostering a safe working environment.

**Breaking Stereotypes:** Challenging traditional notions of masculinity and femininity.

**Inclusive Language:** Promoting the use of gender-neutral and respectful language.

The session concluded with an open discussion, where participants shared personal experiences and insights.

Overall, the workshop succeeded in enhancing participants' understanding of gender issues and empowering them to contribute to a more inclusive society.









